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## INDEPENDENT LEARNING LOG

You will have weekly independent learning logs (ILLs) that will make up a large part of your Habits score. These will involve some choice.

### GRADES

Like other courses at UCW Middle School, grades in Math 7 are weighted as follows:

- 50% **Summative** (Concept Tests and Projects where you show what you know and can do mathematically. Sometimes you will get team discourse scores that are summative.)
- 30% **Formative** (Routine check-ins where I see what you're able to do. These are good places to check that you're understanding what's happening and make changes as necessary. Also, you will get team discourse scores that are formative.)
- 20% **Habits** (Independent Learning Logs, material checks, and scholarlyness.)
